<u>Shoes</u>

If your child is taking any of the following classes, here are the shoes that your dancer will need.

Tap - tan tap shoes (preferably MaryJane style)Pom - tan jazz shoes (no ties)Ballet - pink leather ballet shoesTumbling - NO shoes neededJazz - tan jazz shoes (no ties)Hip-Hop - high top tennis shoesLyrical - foot undeez (tan)Hip-Hop - high top tennis shoes

For the recital, I may order a special color or style of shoe needed to match the costume. This will be billed separately with the costume.

Dance Attire

Dance students will need to be in a leotard or tight fitting dance clothing. Please no baggy pants, shirts, or jeans. During cold weather a sweatshirt will be fine. It's important to see the alignment of the body and makes it much easier to spot without baggy clothing. All long hair should be in a ponytail and/or pulled back away from face.

Payments

Payments are due the first class of each month. A \$5.00 late fee will be added for all payments received after the 10th of the month. Receipts will be given out a few weeks after payment.

Cancellation of classes

During inclement weather if classes need to be cancelled and/or rescheduled I will post on the Facebook page, or you may call my mobile phone (319)470-0794 and I will leave a message stating whether we will have classes or not. I will make a decision by 1:00 p.m., so please call after that time. Cancelled classes will be made up at a later date.

Registration Forms

I will need a dance registration form filled out for each child. If you have not filled out a registration form or registered on the website, please do so as soon as possible so that I have your contact information.
